

# KALGACHIA

## *History-*

Years past when Almighty had desired to remove darkness to enlighten the vast area of West Barpeta on the West bank of river Beki. It is not clear when the village was established, but a few official document states that the village was established in the 16th century. It is believed that due to the large population of *Kal Gaach* ([Banana tree](#)), the name has become Kalgachia (meaning *place where banana trees are found*). The name of the village, east of the settlement of the indigenous Mia was called **kalitapara**. Old Kalgachia village is divided in 1927 into modern **Kalgachia** and **Dimapur**.

The 3rd proposed Kalgachia sub division has been formally declared as 'Kalgachia civil Sub division' of [Barpeta district](#) on 1 January 2016 as a new year gift by then-Congress-led state government. The Kalgachia civil Sub division committee had been formed in 1975 and since then the




demand was raised to form Kalgachia as civil Sub division. Kalgachia is the center place of **Jania** LAC from where **Fakhruddin Ali Ahmed** became a [President of India](#). The proposal was made by sub division committee in June 2015 to form Kalgachia as civil Sub division, presided over by Abdul Khaleque (MLA Jania) And Secretary Md Muzzamel Hussain (Former member, [Assam Public Service Commission](#))

The total population is 29,000 where 17,000 are **male** and 12,000 are female as per 2011 census. Kalgachia Circle of Barpeta district has total population of 195,983 as per the Census 2011. Out of which 101,226 are males while 94,757 are females. In 2011 there were total 36,482 families residing in Kalgachia Circle. The Average Sex Ratio of Kalgachia Circle is 936. The total literacy rate of Kalgachia Circle is 54.18%.

### ***Education-***

**Nabajyoti college** is the higher educational institution and **G K Arabic college** are higher educational institutions in Kalgachia. There are many private institutions in this place. Ataur Rahman College of Education and B.B. College are another two institutions of close to this town. Epitome Computer Institute is the oldest and only certified computer education establishment and a large number of good quality of English Medium and

Assamese medium Schools are Al-Ameen Academy, Ajmal College of Arts & Science, Kalgachia College of Commerce, Kalgachia Collegiate High School, Kalgachia Govt. Aided ME School, K I K High Madrassa, Kalgachia High School, K. K. Pathak high school (one of the oldest schools of this town). There is only one private institution of commerce in present that is Wisdom Academy Kalgachia (A Junior College of Commerce). It has been established only for women's education that is Lokapriya Girls' College, located in Dimapur. Some private sector schools of this town are Radiance Academy, Royal Global English School, Eden Academy, Dolphin Academy, Kalgachia Town Academy, Kalgachia Jatiya Vidyalaya, Kalgachia Adarsha Jatiya Vidyalaya, Fakaruddin Ali Ahmed Academy, and Assam Techno School, Kalgachia etc.

### ***Transport and Communication-***

Kalgachia is located 14 km south of National High Way 31 and well connected by road with [Sarbhog](#) a nearby town. The nearest [railway station](#) is **Sorbhog Railway Station** and the nearest airport is **Gopinath Bardoloi Airport, Gauhati**. Now Kalgachia is well connected with district headquarter **Barpeta** within 20 minutes with the help of New Beki bridge which is completed 2019, along State High Way covering a distance of 17.4 km.

### ***Public Amenities-***

The **Civil Hospital** of Barpeta is situated centrally at Kalgachia Town. In spite of that, there is also **PHC** at Kalgachia town. Kalgachia police outpost is upgraded to **Police Station** and **Fire Brigade** service is also available.
