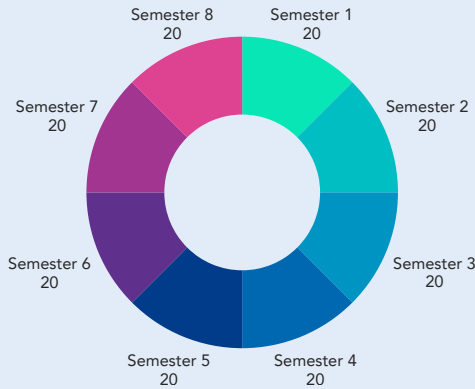

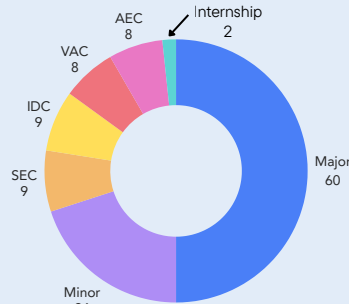

Semester-wise Minimum Credit Requirement

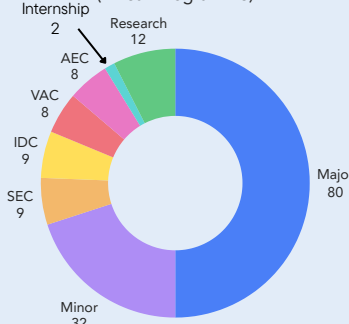

MINIMUM CREDIT REQUIRED FOR A 3-YEAR PROGRAMME

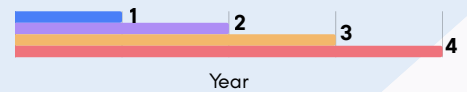

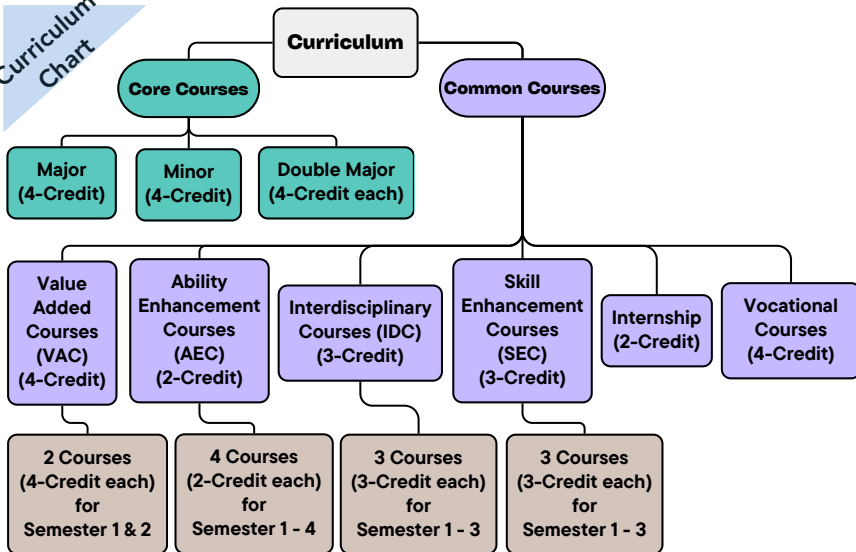

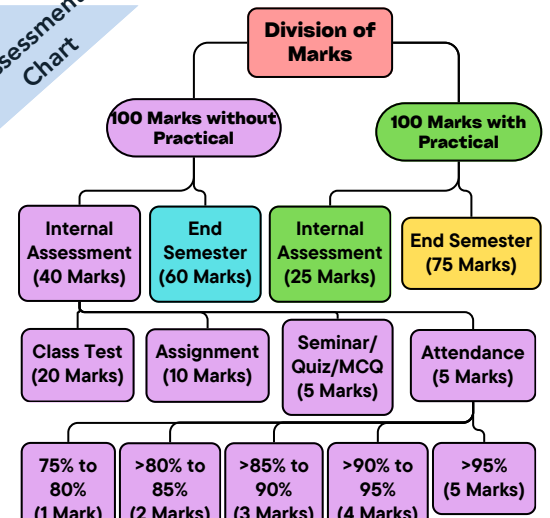

Master of Arts (M.A.)

- **About the Course:** The M.A. in Assamese is a postgraduate programme designed to provide advanced knowledge in Assamese language, literature, linguistics, literary criticism, and cultural studies. The programme aims to develop students' research aptitude, critical thinking, and academic writing skills.
- **Duration:** 2 Years (4 Semesters)
- **Eligibility:** B.A. with Major/Honours in Assamese from a recognized university.
- **Admission:** Postgraduate Entrance Test (PGET) conducted by Bhattadev University.
- **Seat Capacity:** 20
- **Course Structure (Semester-wise)**
 - **Semester I:** Classical Assamese Literature, History of Assamese Literature, Linguistics, Literary Criticism
 - **Semester II:** Medieval Assamese Literature, Modern Assamese Literature, Assamese Grammar and Language Studies, Elective Paper
 - **Semester III:** Indian Literature, Assamese Prose and Poetry, Research Methodology, Elective Paper
 - **Semester IV:** Contemporary Literature, Dissertation / Project Work, Viva Voce (Structure based on PG syllabus framework and CBCS pattern followed by Bhattadev University.)
- **Fees (Approximate):** ₹18,000 – ₹20,000 per year (Self-financed course fee)

Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application (PGDCA)

- **About the Course:** PGDCA is a professional diploma programme designed to provide knowledge in computer applications, programming, database management, and information technology. Bhattadev University offers PGDCA as a self-financing postgraduate diploma programme with limited seat capacity.
- **Duration:** 1 Year (2 Semesters)
- **Eligibility:** Graduate in any discipline from a recognized university.
- **Seat Capacity:** 30
- **Course Structure (Semester-wise)**
 - **Semester I:** Fundamentals of Computer, Operating System, MS Office, Programming in C, Practical
 - **Semester II:** Database Management System, Internet & Web Technology, Software Engineering, Project Work, Practical

Certificate Courses

- **About the Course:** The college offers various short-term certificate and skill-based courses to enhance employability and practical knowledge of students.
- **Objectives:** Skill development, Employment-oriented training, Communication skills, Computer literacy, Language and writing skills

Gauhati University Centre for Distance and Online Education (GUCDOE)

- **About the Course:** Nabajyoti College, Kalgachia functions as a recognised Study Centre of the Gauhati University Centre for Distance and Online Education (GUCDOE). These programmes are offered under the Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode to provide opportunities for higher education to students who are unable to pursue regular courses.
- **Courses Offered:** The GUCDOE offers UGC-DEB approved postgraduate programmes such as M.A. in Assamese, M.A. in English, M.A. in Education, M.A. in Political Science, M.Com, M.Sc. in Information Technology
- **Duration:** Postgraduate Programme: 2 Years (4 Semesters)
- **Eligibility:** Bachelor's Degree from a recognized university.
- **Course Structure (CBCS Pattern):** The postgraduate programme under GUCDOE generally includes Core Papers, Elective Papers, Internal Assignments, Term-End Examination, Project/Dissertation (in final semester)
 - The distance education system includes Self Learning Materials (SLM), assignments, and semester-end examinations.
- **Fees:** Approx. ₹5,000 per semester (includes study materials and examination fees).
- **Total programme fee:** ₹20,000 (approx.).

IMPORTANT RULES AND REGULATIONS

Students are expected to maintain discipline and abide by the rules and regulations of the college. Violation of college rules may lead to disciplinary action.

VEHICLE ENTRY RULES

Students bringing two-wheelers to the college must obtain a Vehicle Entry Pass from the Principal's Office by submitting an application with self-attested copies of Driving License and Registration Certificate (RC). Wearing a helmet is mandatory. The college authority reserves the right to cancel the vehicle entry permit for violation of rules.

EXAMINATION RULES

In addition to the Final/End Semester Examinations conducted by AHSEC and Bhattadev University, students must appear in Sessional Examinations/Unit Tests conducted by the college. The minimum pass marks and examination rules will be as per AHSEC and University regulations. Students must maintain required attendance to appear in examinations.

After submission of online admission form, selected candidates must appear for document verification with original documents and photocopies. Admission will be confirmed only after payment of fees and submission of payment receipt.
